The National Vegetation Classification (NVC)

The NVC is derived from quantitative floristic records compiled from 35,000 vegetation samples taken across the British Isles. Multivariate classification techniques are used to identify discrete plant communities (Rodwell 1992).

The quantitative data has two components: frequency and abundance. **Frequency** refers to how often a plant is found in a series of samples taken from each distinct community (3 samples (quadrates) in the surveys below). **Abundance** is recorded using the DOMIN values which estimates percentage cover on a scale of 1-10.

Each distinct plant community is assigned a code consisting of one or two letters followed by a number. The letters identify the broad community type (e.g. MG for mesotrophic grassland) and the number defines the actual specific community (e.g. mesotrophic grassland is split into 13 communities, MG1 to MG13).
