2 day Hedge Laying Workshops

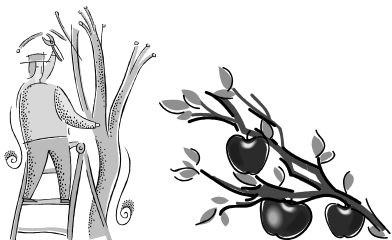

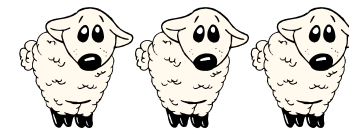
